## 7. Administrator's Report

# a. Interlibrary delivery update (Laepple)

Contract with Brooks Courier Service ended on May 3 and a not-full-time employee has been covering the delivery route since May 13. A new permanent, full-time position in the AFSCME union was approved May 14 and is in recruitment. Laepple thanked the DCL HQ staff for pitching in to sort and deliver items when needed and for the ongoing patience of member libraries. Positive feedback is already being received regarding how quickly items are moving!

## b. 2024-2025 District Negotiated Agreement submission (Laepple)

The 2024-2025 District Negotiated Agreement and 23 member library verifications were submitted to the Office of Commonwealth Libraries for review. Approval is anticipated on or before July 1. The DNA serves as the application for District Aid, so that has been completed. Funding is anticipated in early fall, but is dependent on the State budget passage.
